About Firebrake Wales

The Wales Community Fire Safety Trust, known as Firebrake Wales, is a registered charity and company limited by guarantee established in 2002.

Our mission is to reduce the incidence of deaths and injuries in fires by raising awareness of risks, providing safety information, promoting fire safety research and encouraging collaboration between the public, private and voluntary sectors to make Wales a safer place.

Firebrake Wales is an independent charity but has strong links with the three Welsh Fire and Rescue Services, drawing upon their expert knowledge and support where required.

Our activities are based on the following:

Evidence-based Practice

Using research to target those most at risk of fire, hardest to reach with conventional fire safety messages and those hardest to influence in order to encourage safer attitudes and behaviours. The charity is committed to evaluating and learning from all its activities to achieve continuous improvement in practice and performance.

Partnership Approach

Working with organisations that share an interest in making communities safer. In particular, the charity brings together practitioners from the Fire and Rescue Services, those responsible for the development of fire prevention policies in the Welsh Assembly Government and organisations that engage with communities most at risk, hardest to reach and hardest to influence.

THE WELSH FIRE SAFETY CHARITY

WHY?

“Overall, nearly 80% of all fires involved victims who were impaired in some way, either through substance use, mental or physical impairment (whether or not related to age), or a combination of these factors.

Alongside the immediate causes of a fire (e.g. carelessly discarded cigarettes), **alcohol**, **mobility** and **mental illness** are the biggest single influences on whether a fire starts and/or whether it has fatal consequences”.*

Whether by behaviour or circumstances some groups are more at risk of a fire in the home

The incidence of fires in the home has been steadily decreasing over the past decade. However, evidence shows us that deaths and injuries in home fires are not decreasing evenly amongst all groups of people.

However, many of these groups are often known to and interact with agencies and organisations like yours. It has been recognised that by working with those organisations the fire safety of these vulnerable groups can be improved.

Reaching those most at risk

Amongst these groups individual needs and the level of risk will differ. Partner organisations are more readily able to assess individual levels of need and can help to reach those most at risk where a more general approach is less effective.

We do recognise that the promotion of fire safety may not be part of your core activity. However, working with Firebrake could offer you the support to tackle something which is a recognised risk for your client group.

HOW?

Ynglŷn ag Atal Tân Cymru

Elusen gofrestrdedig a chwmmi cyfyngedig trwy warant yw Ymddiriedolaeth Diogelwch Tân Cymunedol, sy'n adnabyddus dan yr enw Atal Tân Cymru, ac fe'i sefydlwyd yn 2002.

Ein cenhadaeth yw gostwng nifer y marwolaethau a'r anafiadau mewn tanau, a hynny trwy godi ymwybyddiaeth am y peryglon, darparu gwybodaeth am ddiogelwch, hyrwyddo ymchwil i ddiogelwch tân, ac annog cydweithredu rhwng y sectorau cyhoeddus, preifat a gwirfoddol er mwyn gwneud Cymru'n wlad fwy diogel.

Elusen annibynnol yw Atal Tân Cymru, ond mae ganddi gysylltiadau cryf gyda'r tri Gwasanaeth Tân ac Achub yng Nghymru, gan fanteisio ar eu gwybodaeth arbenigol a'u cefnogaeth lle bo angen.

Mae ein gweithgareddau wedi eu seilio ar y canlynol:

Ymarfer yn seiliedig ar dystiolaeth

Defnyddio ymchwil i dargedu'r rhai sydd fwyaf mewn perygl o dân, y rhai sydd fwyaf anodd eu cyrraedd gyda'r negeseuon diogelwch tân arferol, a'r rhai y mae'n fwyaf anodd dylanwadu arnynt, a hynny er mwyn annog agweddau ac ymddygiadau mwy diogel. Mae'r elusen wedi ymrwymo i werthuso a dysgu o ganlyniad i'w holl weithgareddau er mwyn cael gwelliant parhaus o ran arferion a pherfformiad.

Dull Partneriaethol

Gweithio gyda sefydliadau sy'n rhannu'r diddordeb mewn gwneud cymunedau'n fwy diogel. Yn arbennig, mae'r elusen yn dwyn ynghyd ymarferwyr o'r Gwasanaethau Tân ac Achub, y rhai sy'n gyfrifol am ddatblygu polisiâu atal tanau yn Llywodraeth y Cynulliad, a sefydliadau sy'n meithrin perthynas â chymunedau sydd fwyaf mewn perygl, y rhai sydd fwyaf anodd eu cyrraedd a'r rhai y mae'n fwyaf anodd dylanwadu arnynt.

“Yn gyffredinol, roedd bron 80% o'r holl danau yn ymwneud â dioddefwyr oedd ag amhariad o ryw fath, naill ai trwy ddefnyddio sylweddau, amhariad meddyliol neu gorfforol (boed yn gysylltiedig ag oedran neu beidio), neu gyfuniad o'r ffactorau hyn.

Ynghyd â'r achosion uniongyrchol i dân (e.e. bod yn ddiotal wrth gael gwared ar sigarêts) **alcohol**, **symudedd** a **salwch meddwl** yw'r dylanwadau unigol mwyaf ar p'un ai y bydd tân yn cychwyn a/neu p'un ai y mae iddo ganlyniadau angheuol”.*

Boed oherwydd ymddygiad neu amgylchiadau, mae rhai grwpiau mewn mwy o berygl o dân yn y cartref

Mae nifer y tanau yn y cartref wedi bod yn gostwng yn gyson dros y degawd diwethaf. Fodd bynnag, mae tystiolaeth yn dangos nad yw'r marwolaethau a'r anafiadau yn gostwng yn gyfartal rhwng pob grŵp o bobl.

Fodd bynnag, yn aml mae llawer o'r grwpiau hyn yn gyfarwydd i asiantaethau a sefydliadau fel eich un chi, ac mewn cysylltiad â hwy. Cydnabuwyd y gellid gwella diogelwch tân y grwpiau bregus hyn trwy weithio gyda'r sefydliadau hynny.

Cyrraedd y rhai sydd fwyaf mewn perygl
